- Platonic Relationships: Friendships and 'friends with benefits" are a form of ethical sluthood for the physical and emotional connection the relationship can provide.
- One Night Stand: 'Friendly Sex' provides only the physical needs of the individuals. However, sexual needs are part of ethical sluthood.
- Singles: is a relationship with yourself to better understand you desires, needs and boundaries which is encourage in ethical sluthood.
- Partnership: Open, Polyamorous, Tribes, swing relationships regardless of sexuality are base on trust, understanding, communication, openness, consent and sexual desires. All these are qualities the ethical sluts has.
- BDMS/Dominance and Submission: these type of relationship are very sexual and communication is a must! The ethical slut listen to their lover's wants and need with affection. Safety is always first in ethical sluthood.
- Group Sex/ Orgies: multiple sex partners are natural and fine with consent and safe sex. Sexual expression and fulfillment are very important to the ethical slut.
